About the Trustee Board

Our charity Trustee Board is ultimately responsible for making the big decisions about the running of the Guild. The Board is comprised of **18** people including Guild Officers, University representatives, industry professionals and fellow students – all of whom bring different types of experience and expertise to the role. The Student Trustee roles are:

- 1. Undergraduate Student Trustee (open for applications)
- 2. Postgraduate Student Trustee (open for applications)
- 3. BAME Student Trustee
- 4. International Student Trustee

About the Role

The Guild is on a mission to increase the diversity of our representatives; **we especially welcome applications from student of colour as well as identifying as disabled**. All students are welcome to apply.

Being a Trustee is a voluntary role and involves attending 6 Trustee Board meetings each year, plus some preparation time before each one. Our Trustees are an incredibly important part of our governance and play an integral role in the continued running and development of the Guild. Ideally the successful candidate will graduate in July 2025 or later, however we will consider suitable applications from all students which fir the criteria.
