

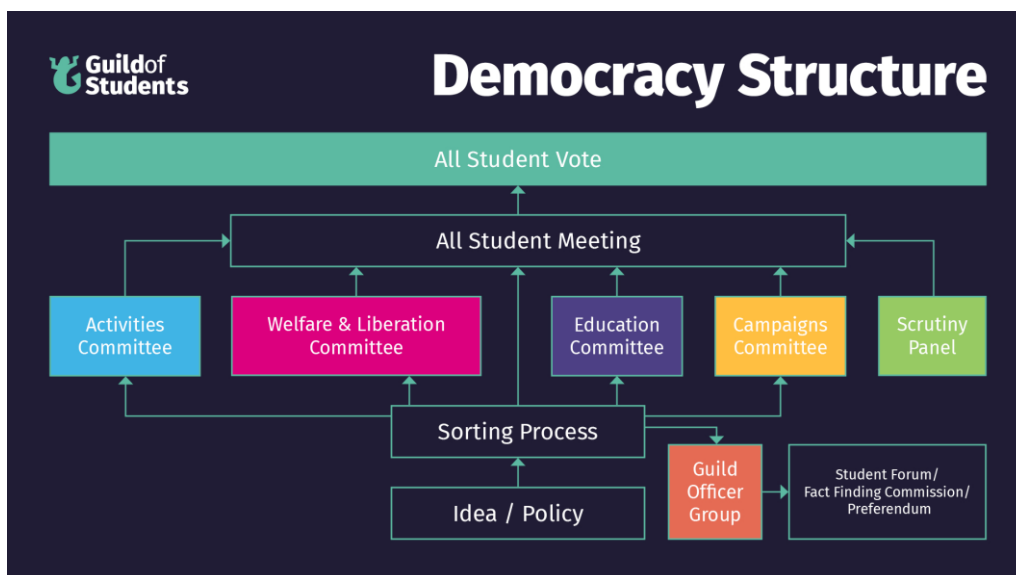
What is the All Student Meeting?

The All Student Meeting is part of the Guild’s democratic (democracy) structure. It’s an online meeting that takes place 3 times a year, and it’s where ALL Officers and ALL UoB students come together to discuss and collectively make decisions on big student ideas and policy proposals.



Ideas and policy proposals that the decision-making committees (Activities, Welfare & Liberation, Education and Campaigns) cannot make a decision on, and items related to the Guild’s aims as a charity, may also be discussed at this meeting.

The All Student Meeting also has to be “quorate”. The quorum for All Student Meeting is 1% of the student population (approx. 370 students last year). If the meeting is not quorate, the ideas and/or policies have to be referred to an online All Student Vote.



What is the Chair of All Student Meeting?

The Chair of All Student Meeting chairs (leads and facilitates) the All Student Meetings. Officers and/or students may also take the lead on items being discussed. ALL registered UoB students can attend and contribute to the All Student Meeting. No previous experience with the Guild or previous experience with chairing is required for the Chair of All Student Meeting role, as full training will be provided by the Guild.

The position of Chair of All Student Meeting is also open to all registered UoB students.

The role of the Chair is to:

- Chair all meetings of the All Student Meeting
- Act in an official capacity at a meeting of All Student Meeting
- Encourage fair and accessible discussions on these ideas and policies
- Empower student members to hold to account, and direct the Guild Officers.
- Remain impartial during debates and discussions, and refrain from demonstrating bias at any point.
- Ensure that minutes and records of meetings are kept, and manage its correspondence and notices (minutes are taken by Student Voice staff)
- Ensure that agendas and papers for All Student Meeting are available to all students
- Rule on matters relating to the agenda items
- Oversee the Allocations Procedure
