

## Working in the UK as a Croatian national

**You must apply for a yellow registration certificate if you want to work while you're a student in the UK.**

You can only work for up to 20 hours a week in term-time, unless you're training to do a specific job (a 'vocational course') and the course includes a work placement which is vital to your study.

You need:

- to have private comprehensive health insurance or a European Health Insurance Card (EHIC)
- a letter from your UK college, university or other place of study with the name of your course and the start and end dates
- proof that you've got enough money to support yourself - either bank statements or a letter from your sponsor or funder

### Self-employed people

You don't need a certificate to work for yourself in the UK if you're self-employed, but you can apply for a yellow registration certificate to prove your right to be self-employed.

You must [register for Self Assessment](#) if you're self-employed
